Through the weekly Kid's Corner we are reaching out to you the parents/grandparents so you can cultivate a Fun and unforgettable learning experience for the children.

Here is how you can use this information:

First print the masks preferably on card stock so they will last. Masks also come with sides shaped like the sides of reading glasses, which should be cut and pasted to each mask. You may choose to punch holes on side of the mask and attach string to them.

Now the fun begins. Collect glitter, glue, feathers, yarn, bright colored markers and let the kids decorate the mask.

Once the mask is created, children can begin to learn about Bible characters.

The enclosed character card provides enough information on each Bible character including the year of his birth so you can teach how God used that Bible hero to serve Him.
